Happenings at the Pulaski Area Historical Society

Excitement in downtown Pulaski is beginning to heat up along with the weather. The Pulaski Area Historical Society in cooperation with Plants of Distinction is hosting a **Heirloom Plant Sale** on **May 14 and May 21**, 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. each day. The plant sale will be held at the museum, 129 W. Pulaski Street. The museum will also be open to the public on both of these dates.

The plants featured will be unusual varieties of plants exclusively grown by Plants of Distinction for the Pulaski Historical Society. The varieties of plants that will be available are: Makaronowa warszawska squash, German Pink Tomato, Hungarian Heart Tomato, Black Krim Tomato, Amish Paste Tomato, Black Beauty Tomato, Janosik Melon, Pride of WI melon, Minnesota Midget Melon, Purple Sicilian Cauliflower, Mammoth Red Cabbage, Marta Polka Peppers and Red Belgian Peppers. All proceeds from the sale will benefit the Pulaski Area Historical Society.

In addition, on May 19, as part of a unique event that will be held in Brown County, the Pulaski Area Historical Society Museum will be open to the public for a **History Treasure Tour**. In total, eleven historical societies will be featured and open on that Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The Pulaski Museum will have historians on hand for the public to ask questions, and learn more about Pulaski, Wisconsin and its rich Polish heritage. Visitors will also be able to get a taste of Pulaski with some favorite featured Polish food samples available along with refreshments. Admission is free at all local societies.
